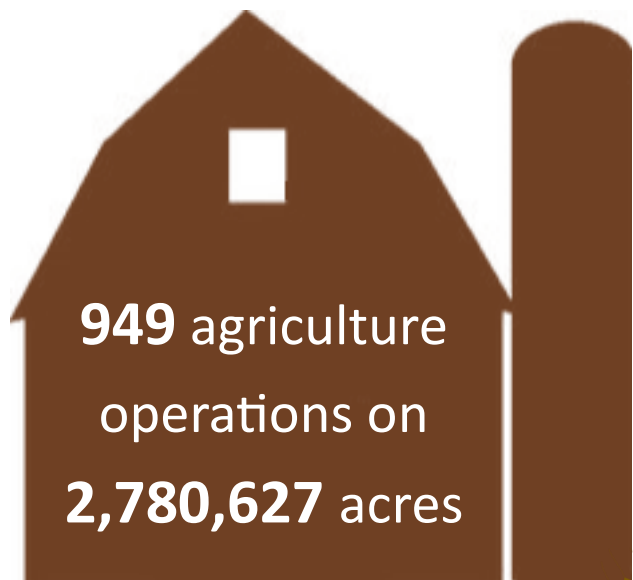



Ag Production in Fergus and Petroleum Counties



\$188.8 million of revenue in 2017¹
That's **\$16,240** for each county resident!




454,000,000 pounds of wheat harvested in 2018,...

34,396,000 pounds of beef produced in 2018,...

...enough to supply **3,440,000 people** for one year²

...enough to supply **625,380 people** for one year³



That means the **average farm** in Fergus/Petroleum Counties produces enough **wheat** to supply **3,620 people**, and enough **beef** to supply **650 people** for a whole year!
