- Each competitor should have a unique Token ID and an answer sheet. This will be used for inputting your answers at the end of the contest. You will have 1 hour following the contest to enter your answers on the submission site - <https://secure.georgia4h.org/poultry>.
- All classes will be viewed together as a group.
  - We will go through each class once then if you need to see a question again, please type in the chat box.
  - Some of the eggs may be brown, do not give them a lower grade because of this. Judge them as if they have a white shell. *Dark shells can affect candling so brown eggs will appear darker in the candling class.*
- You will be placed into a breakout room for Oral Reasons.
  - There will be 2 junior reason rooms, 2 senior reason rooms.
  - Please turn on your camera and audio for reasons, look into your camera and speak up.
  - After you give your reasons please exit the Zoom meeting and go to the answer submission site. You do not need to return to the Zoom meeting again.
- Results will be announced via Zoom using the same meeting link from today on Wednesday, June 10 @ 2:00 pm. This will be recorded and scores will be uploaded to the 4-H Event Registration System.

- After you have delivered your reasons to your judge, please exit Zoom meeting all together and input your scores into the scoring system.



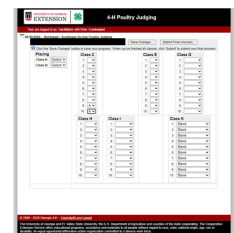
### Order of Classes

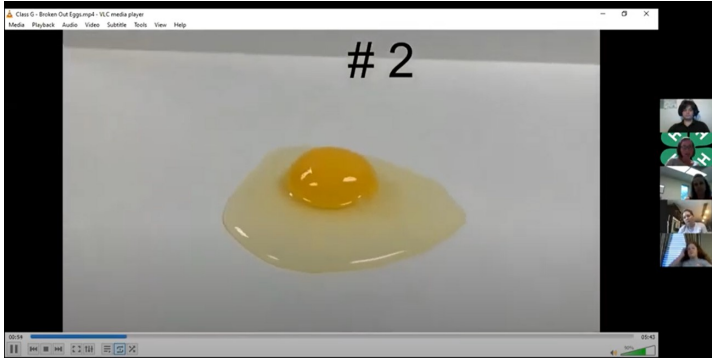

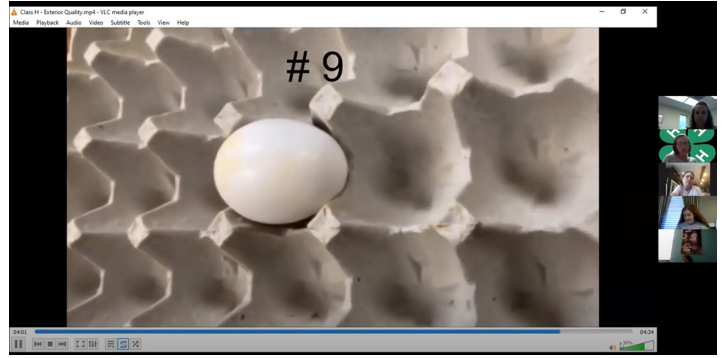

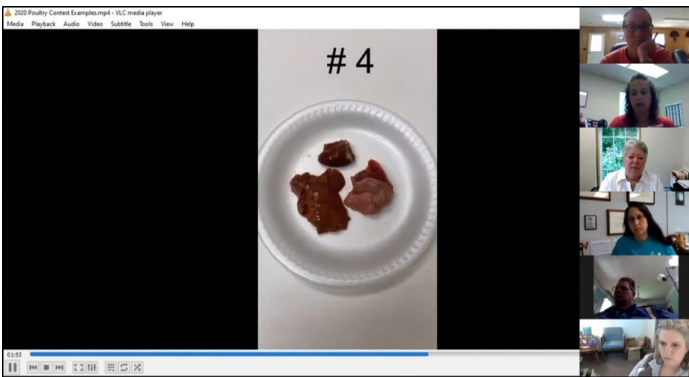

Broken Out Eggs



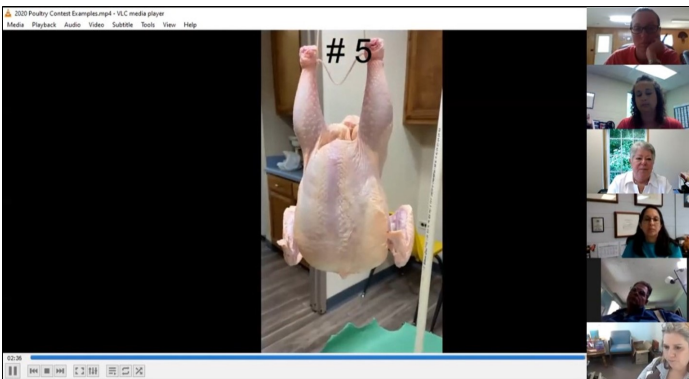
Exterior Egg Quality
