

Harvesting and Sawmill Tour



Join representatives from the Clemson Extension FNR team and the SC Forestry Commission for a day-long tour of an active timber harvesting operation and the Canfor Southern Pine Sawmill in Kershaw County. Procurement foresters and logging company employees will guide participants through the harvesting process, from the cutting and merchandising of wood at the logging site to its transportation to the mill. At Canfor, mill employees will guide the group through the lumber processing operations, from the arrival of wood at the mill, to each step of sawing into lumber, and then to the packaging and transportation of the final products.

Throughout the tour, participants will gain a better understanding of timber harvesting operations and the requirements for the wood utilized in lumber production.

Participants will board vans at the Clemson University Sandhill Research and Education Center located at 900 Clemson Road, Columbia, South Carolina 29229.
