



The Panhandle Cattlemen's College Pasture Class was an add-on field day hosted where clients worked hands-on with state specialists to prepare ground and plant different forage crops using tractors and implements. Additionally, participants laid out and built a fence, calibrated a sprayer and a planter, identified weeds, and took soil samples. This program included the collaboration of multiple state specialists and county agents.
