Family, Forests, Future (F³) is for new and beginning forest owners looking for a foundation of forest management and health knowledge. It provides an overview of landowner assistance programs and will introduce participants to forestry professionals and resources throughout the state. It incorporates five self-paced modules, discussions, quizzes, and other web-based methods of participant-instructor interaction, along with two optional forestry tours.
