
Scholarship Program

The Scholarship Committee updated vesting requirements and eligibility regarding monetary amounts for people requesting scholarships. The changes are:

- Member vestment (after July 22, 2022) is:
 - Member vestment increased to \$100 to qualify for up to \$1,500 scholarship and \$200 (an additional \$100 contribution to the scholarship fund) to qualify for an additional scholarship award from \$1,501 to \$3,000 (no more than \$1,500 in any one year will be awarded).
- Effective date for this change is for 2023 scholarship requests!

In a nutshell...

You need to invest \$100 into the NACAA Educational Foundation, one year **PRIOR** to applying for a scholarship.

Outstanding Farmers of America


