

NACAA Ag & Cultural Tour of Portugal & Spain September 29 - October 6, 2024

Day 1 (Saturday, September 28) - Evening departure from the U.S. for an overnight flight to Lisbon, Portugal.

Day 2 (Sunday, September 29) - Arrival in the Lisbon airport this morning, depart for Evora, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Upon arrival, enjoy a city tour and lunch while exploring Evora. You will also visit the Chapel of Bones in Evora, which is part of the larger Royal Church of St. Francis, and was constructed by Franciscan monks in the late 16th century. Later in the day, check in to your accommodations for a two night stay.

Day 3 (Monday, September 30) - Today spend the day visiting a ranch that has a variety of mixed agriculture production. You will visit sights such as oyster production, equine stud farm, rice, cattle, swine and cork production. Lunch will be on the ranch

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overlooking the estuary connected to the Atlantic Ocean. This ranch is connected to a nature preserve that works within the local environmental laws that are utilized throughout the European Union.

Day 4 (Tuesday, October 1) - Check out and depart to the dramatic Algarve coast. This area is known for its picturesque coastline and stunning cliffs. You will visit a goat/sheep dairy and cheese farm in the morning before having lunch. Also, visit Cabo da Sao Vicente which is the southwesternmost part of Portugal (as legend calls it, the end of the world). Enjoy the remainder of your time exploring the area by touring the breathtaking cliff lines with plenty of photo opportunities and some free time to explore the small shops and cafes.

Explore Maria Luisa Park, a spacious park with beautiful gardens, fountains, and tiled promenades, along with the beautiful architecture of Spain's Plaza. This afternoon, take part in a cooking lesson making Spain's most famous dish, paella. After the paella lunch, relax during some free time or go sightseeing and shopping at the local shops nearby. Visit Castle Hill (a nice walk to stretch your legs after a long flight), Alfama neighborhood (birthplace of Fado music) and taste local food and beverages as you visit shops and restaurants along the way. In the afternoon, visit the Botanical Garden of Lisbon which was laid out between 1858 and 1873. The garden has over 18,000 species and is one of the largest collections of subtropical vegetation. Later, visit the Belem tower and try some traditional baked goods. Farewell dinner near your hotel in Lisbon!
