The NACAA-AMPIC Animal Science Pre-Tour is set. The registration fee is \$150.00. There is a block of rooms at the DoubleTree Hotel in Billings, MT, set aside for the night of June 26th, 2025.

Call **406-252-7400** and ask for the Animal Science Pre-Tour Block of Rooms. The deadline for reserving rooms at the DoubleTree Hotel is **May 28th, 2025**.

We will leave the Double Tree Hotel in Billings, MT, on the morning of June 27th. The group will be traveling on a chartered bus. We will make several stops along the way to Great Falls, MT, and we will spend the night there. We will be staying at the Holiday Inn (1100 5th Street South, Great Falls, MT). PRO TIPS FOR HORTICULTURE AND TURFGRASS PRE-TOUR PARTICIPANTS

Bring 10 items that represent your state to give to our tour stop guides. Popular items in the past have been everything from buckeyes (candy) to pens and popcorn. There will be a LOT of walking. Good athletic shoes are best. Extra socks are also good. Sunscreen, hat, and insect repellent are always a must. Be timely. If we start getting behind, then we lose time at our next tour stop. Average high and low temperatures for Bozeman/Billings are 76 degrees and 48 degrees, respectively, so wear layers. Bring a tip for the bus driver. \$5 per day/person is typical.

Be prepared to ask questions and be engaged. Our speakers love that. Bring your phone to take photos of the screen or a notepad.

Congratulations to our Regional Winners in the NACAA Research and Education poster contest. We had a record year of poster submissions this year with a total of 178 posters submitted. Most of those posters submitted will be displayed at the 2025 NACAA AMPIC in Billings, Montana. Judging of the national poster contest will take place on Monday morning, June 30th, and the top 3 in each category will be announced. This year's poster session will be a little different from past AMPIC's.

All posters will need to be displayed by 4:30 pm, Sunday, June 29th. Check-in times are from 9:00 am and 4:30 pm. Poster displays will be located on the 22nd Floor of the Doubletree in the Ponderosa Room. Please check in when you arrive, and you will be allowed to mount your poster. Our poster mounting will be different from years past. We will not have the hard sided boards. The posters will be mounted on pipe and drape. We will provide a means to mount the posters. If you haven't printed your poster it might hang better if your poster was printed on cloth. You will not be penalized for not printing on cloth. If travel restrictions do not allow you to arrive by 4:30 pm on Sunday, please let Brian Haller, Poster National Chair, know as soon as possible. You can contact him by cell phone at 501-230-9971.

There will be an "meet the authors" poster session on Monday, June 30th at 10:00 – 10:30 a.m. and 3:00 – 3:30 p.m.. Posters will be taken down at 3:30 p.m. following the "meet the authors" session.

Awards for the research and education posters will take place in concurrence with the Communications luncheon on Monday, June 30th. This is an invite only luncheon for the regional finalists.
